Objective

Global Carbon Capture and Storage Institute (GCCSI) plans to publish the Technology Compendium 2025 in line with our mission to accelerate the deployment of carbon capture and storage (CCS). The aim is to provide a platform for technology owners and providers to display their products and allow project developers, proponents, and interested parties to discover the field's state-of-the-art offerings.

Scope of the Publication

The compendium covers technologies with a Technology Readiness Level (TRL) equal or greater than 5 in the three main sections of the full value chain of CCS: (1) Capture, (2) Transport, and (3) Storage.

Before Submission

Non-members must submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) and fill in the form as soon as possible to introduce the technologies you are planning to propose. The expression of interest is not the submission for inclusion. Please fill in the Expression of Interest as soon as possible. For Members of the Institute, contact through your Account Manager is acceptable.

GCCSI will review your submission and reply to you. A submission template and directions for submission will be sent with the reply email should your EOI be accepted.

Submission Requirements and Format

To be considered for inclusion in the Technology Compendium 2025, information must be submitted through the Zoho Form portal: [Link available to Members and EOI only.](#)

The items that must be submitted are as follows:

1. A single manuscript per technology – In a simple Word format. Please refer to the template for the approximate word length and headings.
2. Images – Primary "Hero" image and optional additional images, in separate files. Ideally, these images are in a vector file or high-resolution format.
3. Company logo - a separate file in a vector file or high-resolution format.

If you contributed to the Technology Compendium 2024 and have no updates to make, we now have an “**Express Resubmission**” option where content will be brought forward from last year’s submission without changes. Review Process

GCCSI will retain editorial oversight for the Technology Compendium 2025 and may ask for further evidence to support any claims about the provided technology. This can happen through specific arrangements to validate claims involving confidential information.

Before finalising the submissions, the Institute's experts will review the submissions and may ask for revisions as needed. If further discussion is required, they will arrange for meetings. Once our graphic designer prepares the final version, it will be sent for your last review before publication.

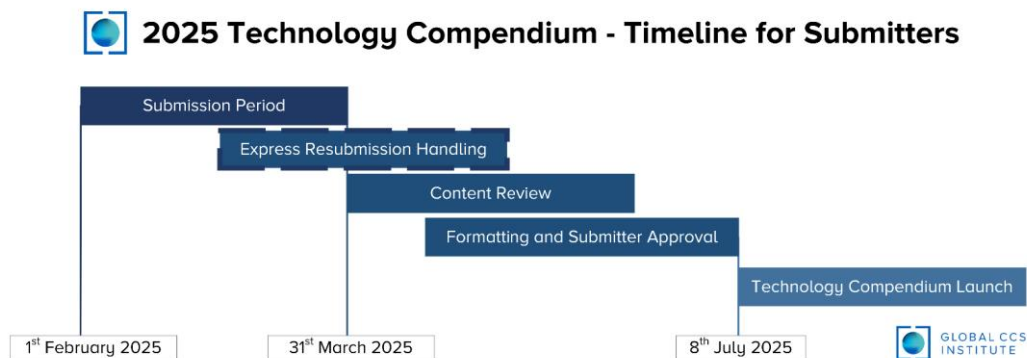
