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Pathways Alliance Oil Sands CCS Project

The Pathways Alliance is a partnership involving Canadian Natural, Cenovus, ConocoPhillips Canada, Imperial, MEG Energy, and Suncor. Its proposed carbon capture and storage project would have the capacity to transport captured CO₂ from multiple oil sands facilities to a hub in the Cold Lake area of Alberta for permanent underground storage.

Engineers and technical experts from Pathways member companies have been advancing engineering, regulatory, and environmental work for the project application and engaging Indigenous and other local communities along the proposed pipeline route.
